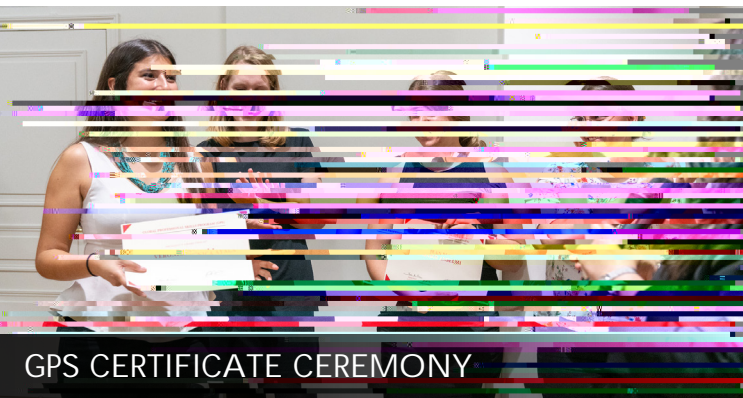

AUP was born in the heart of the 7ème arrondissement of Paris, and from its humble roots in the basement of the American Church in Paris, has built an academic home for international students.

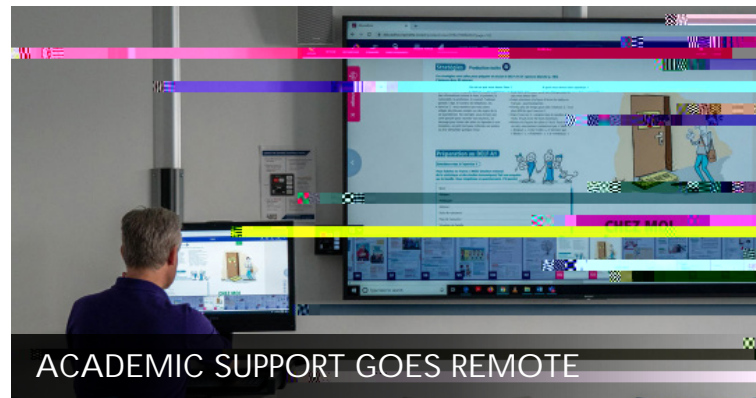

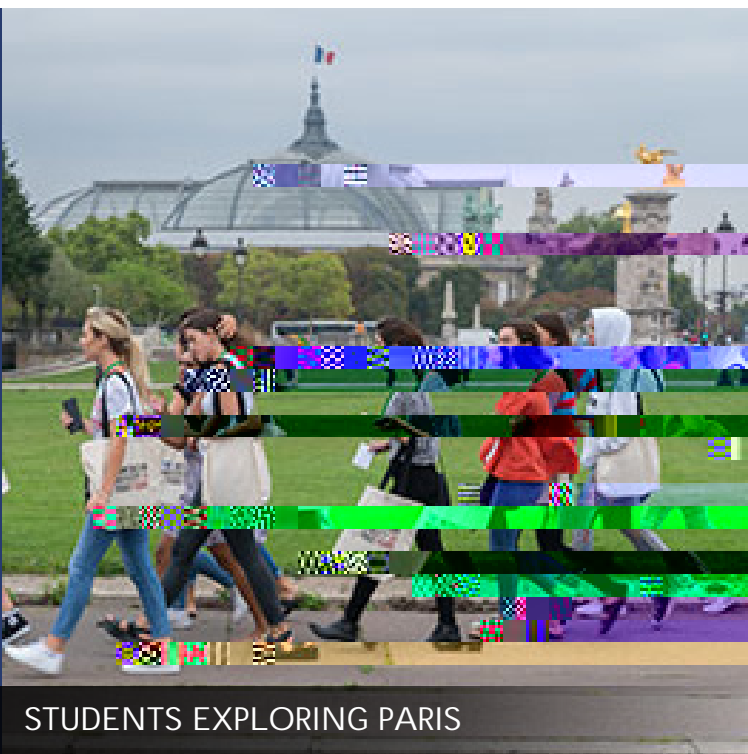
AUP'S ATRIUM IN THE QUAI D'ORSAY LEARNING COMMONS
